### TRAVEDUTSIDE THE U.S.

If you travel abroad, you must take the following documents temter:

- x Passport (valid at least 6 months beyond your expected return date to the U.S.);
- x Valid J1 visa; and
- x DS2019 endorsed for travel.

We also recommend that you bring proof that you are conducting the objective for which you were provided the Jt visa (e.g., students may provide an enrollment verification letter and scholars may provide a confirmation letter from their supervisor).

### Travel Endorsement

Before traveling outside the U.S., bring your **2005**9 to the International Center and complete the Travel Signature Requestor. An RO or ARO will endorse your **2005**9 to confirm you are in good standing at The University of Akron. This signature remains valid for 1 year from the date of signature, or until the end date on your **DS**019 (whichever is earlier). The signature of signature of your SEVIS record has been terminated.

### Minimum Insurance Requirements

- x Medical benefits of at least \$100,000 per accident or illness;
- x Repatriation of remains in the amount of \$25,000;
- x Expenses associated with medical evacuation to your home country in the amount of at least \$50,000;
- x A deductible not to exceed \$500 per advenit or illness;
- x Underwritten by an insurance corporation with an A.M. Best rating of &Aabove, an Insurance Solvency International, Ltd. (ISI) rating of Aor above, a Standard & Poor's Claims Paying Ability Rating of A' or above, a Weiss Resea, Inc., rating of B+" or above, or be backed by the full faith and credit of your home country's government.
